This FREE program is open to all Jewish families as a chance to learn, play, and grow Jewishly *together!* B’yachad is a collaborative early learning program for Jewish children ages 4 and younger with their parents. This once-a-month program is for preschools who are not attending a weekly religious school program. It is co-sponsored by Temple Beth El and Heska Amuna Religious Schools and led by Anna Iroff-Bailey.

Each B’yachad class will include stories, music, visits from a rabbi, snack, and Jewish toddler activities– crafts, games, singing, dancing, and more! This program is open to all Jewish families, regardless of congregation affiliation or non-affiliation.
